With their attempt to reach Madagascar in 2018 being postponed due to civil riots, Prabhu and Nancy received a clear call from God to visit this summer instead, along with requests to visit Malawi, South Africa and to return to build on their work in Mauritius last summer (see overleaf).


As ever, plans are coming together in faith that the finance required will be in place. Please pray for the trip, and whether you are able to support it financially.

God Moves In Mauritius

May - July 2018

God moved powerfully throughout this 51 day trip despite the late cancellation of a visit to Madagascar. Prabhu and Nancy continually experienced God's hand of provision and blessing as they overcame significant adversity to participate in 106 meetings!

This relentless but fruitful schedule included church services and vision sharing, training, counselling and visits to a Christian institution and several families with children with disabilities.

Additionally, the Rayans attended a Global Leadership Summit, where they shared the vision and met pastors and leaders from neighbouring countries including Seychelles, Reunion, Madagascar, South African and Malaysia.

Highlights of the visit:

- More than 1900 people heard the vision
- More than 1000 people accepted Christ or re-dedicated their lives to Him
- 33 pastors from a variety of denominations committed to implement the vision in their own churches and through their networks
- Attended or lead 106 meetings including 16 training and councelling sessions

About Inclusive Worldwide (IW)

Inclusive Worldwide is the working name for International Fellowship for the Handicapped, a mission to people who have the kinds of disabilities which cause them to be socially stigmatised. World Health Organisation statistics estimate that about 15% of the world's population is disabled, equivalent to the third largest nation on earth! However, people with disabilities are among the least evangelised and least included in church. IW aims to reach them with the good news of Jesus Christ, to involve them in the life of the church and society, and to raise awareness among the Christian Church of their spiritual needs.

IW seeks to recruit, train and support volunteers and workers to pioneer this work amongst the indigenous church and people with disability across the nations. IW has impacted over 80 countries, with Prabhu and Nancy having personally shared the vision by visiting over 40.

About Prabhu and Nancy Rayan

Prabhu and Nancy founded and pioneer the ministry of **International Fellowship for the Handicapped** (now known as **Inclusive Worldwide**) for 28 years. They have travelled extensively throughout the world sharing the Gospel with people with disabilities and encouraging churches to include and disciple them. Based in Chennai, India, they also run an Indian ministry, **India Fellowship for the Visually Handicapped**.
